



22 A CEREMONIAL RESOLUTION

25 IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

28 To recognize and honor the Dupont Circle Citizens Association for its distinguished service and
29 civic contributions to the people of the District of Columbia, on the occasion of its 100th
30 anniversary.

32 WHEREAS, since 1922, the Dupont Circle Citizens Association has been the premier
33 civic organization in the Dupont Circle area, bringing residents, businesses, and non-profit
34 organizations together to improve the quality of life in an active and diverse urban neighborhood;

35 WHEREAS, the Dupont Circle Citizens Association was an early proponent of
36 preserving Dupont's historic buildings and residential character;

37 WHEREAS, the Dupont Circle Citizens Association has advocated for public
38 improvements and enhanced city services to maintain a physical environment that attracts
39 residents and the businesses and services that support them;

40 WHEREAS, during the 1960s, the Dupont Circle Citizens Association started its annual
41 House Tours, showcasing historic residences and buildings, and demonstrating how new
42 development can be compatible with a rich historical legacy;

43 WHEREAS, the Dupont Circle Citizens Association was instrumental in developing
44 widely accepted guidelines for sidewalk cafes that balance resident and business interests and
45 create a vibrant streetscape;

46 WHEREAS, for more than 20 years, the Dupont Circle Citizens Association has
47 supported and marched in the annual Pride Parade;

48 WHEREAS, the Dupont Circle Citizens Association has successfully promoted volunteer
49 efforts, fund raising, and charitable giving to improve local schools, increase tree canopy
50 coverage, maintain parks and gardens, restore the historic police and fire callboxes, enhance
51 local cultural institutions, and support responsible dog ownership throughout the neighborhood;

52 WHEREAS, the Dupont Circle Citizens Association’s recent activities have included an
53 extensive community education series on homelessness in the neighborhood, exploration of the
54 history of racism in housing policy, and the restoration of the T Street Park; and

55 WHEREAS, the major legacies of Dupont Circle Citizens Association over the past 100
56 years have been the preservation of the architectural character and environment of Dupont Circle
57 and fostering citizen engagement.

58 RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this
59 resolution may be cited as the “Dupont Circle Citizens Association Centennial Anniversary
60 Recognition Resolution of 2022”.

61 Sec. 2. The Council recognizes and honors Dupont Circle Citizens Association on its
62 100th anniversary for its exceptional contributions and commitment to improving the lives of
63 District residents.

64 Sec. 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon the first date of publication in
65 the District of Columbia Register.
